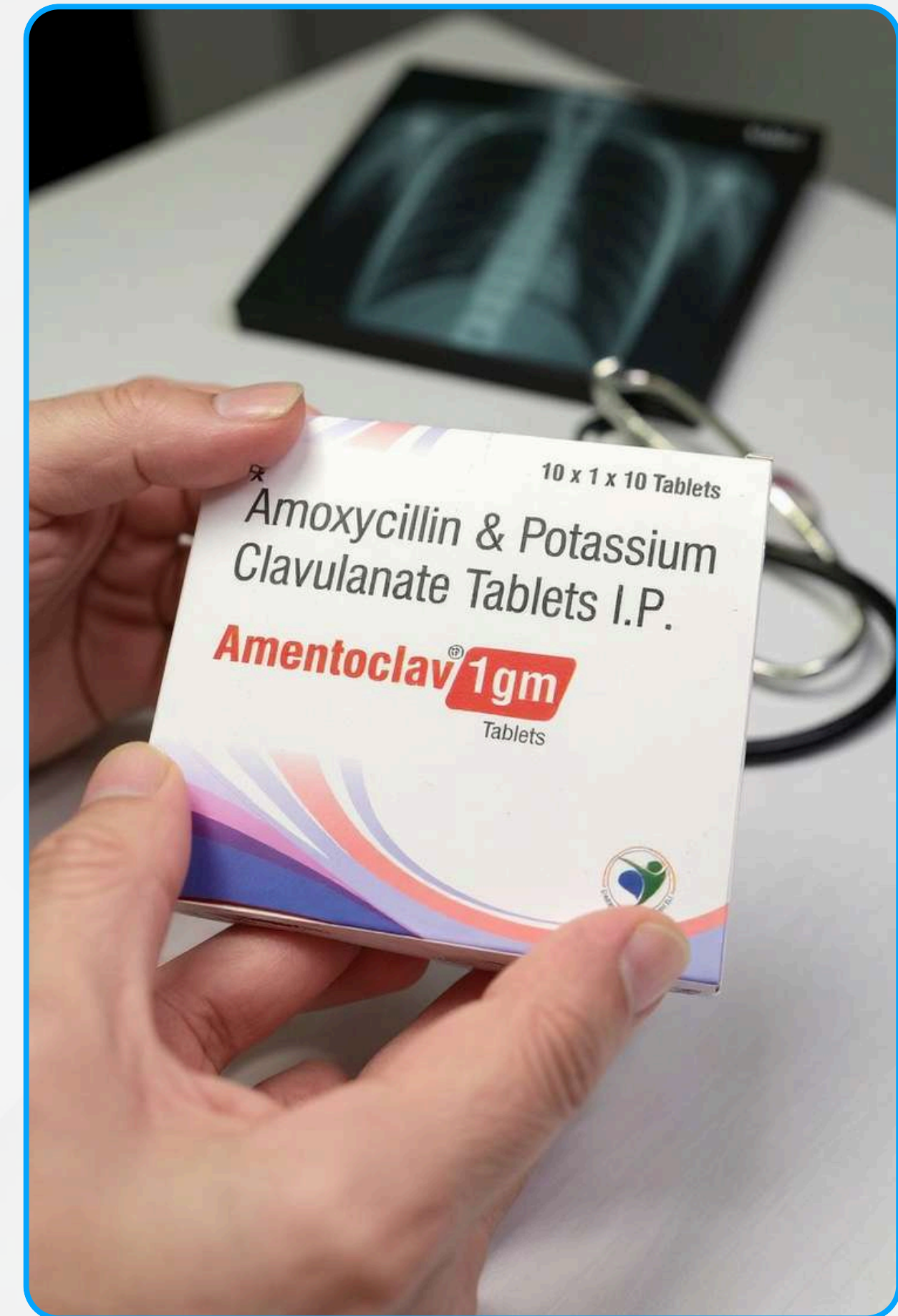
Composition

Amoxicillin Trihydrate 875 mg + Clavulanic Acid 125 mg

Classification

Potent broad-spectrum antibiotic with beta-lactamase inhibition

- Combines penicillin-class bactericidal action with beta-lactamase inhibition
- Effective against resistant bacterial strains
- Ensures high efficacy in mixed and recurrent infections

Amoxicillin (Penicillin Derivative)

- Broad-spectrum antibacterial activity
- Effective against gram-positive & gram-negative bacteria
- Strong tissue penetration



Clavulanic Acid (Beta-lactamase Inhibitor)

- Protects Amoxicillin from enzymatic degradation
- Restores antibacterial activity against resistant bacteria
- Widens therapeutic spectrum

Standard Dosage

1 Tablet of Amentoclav 1gm (Amoxicillin 875 mg + Clavulanic Acid 125 mg)

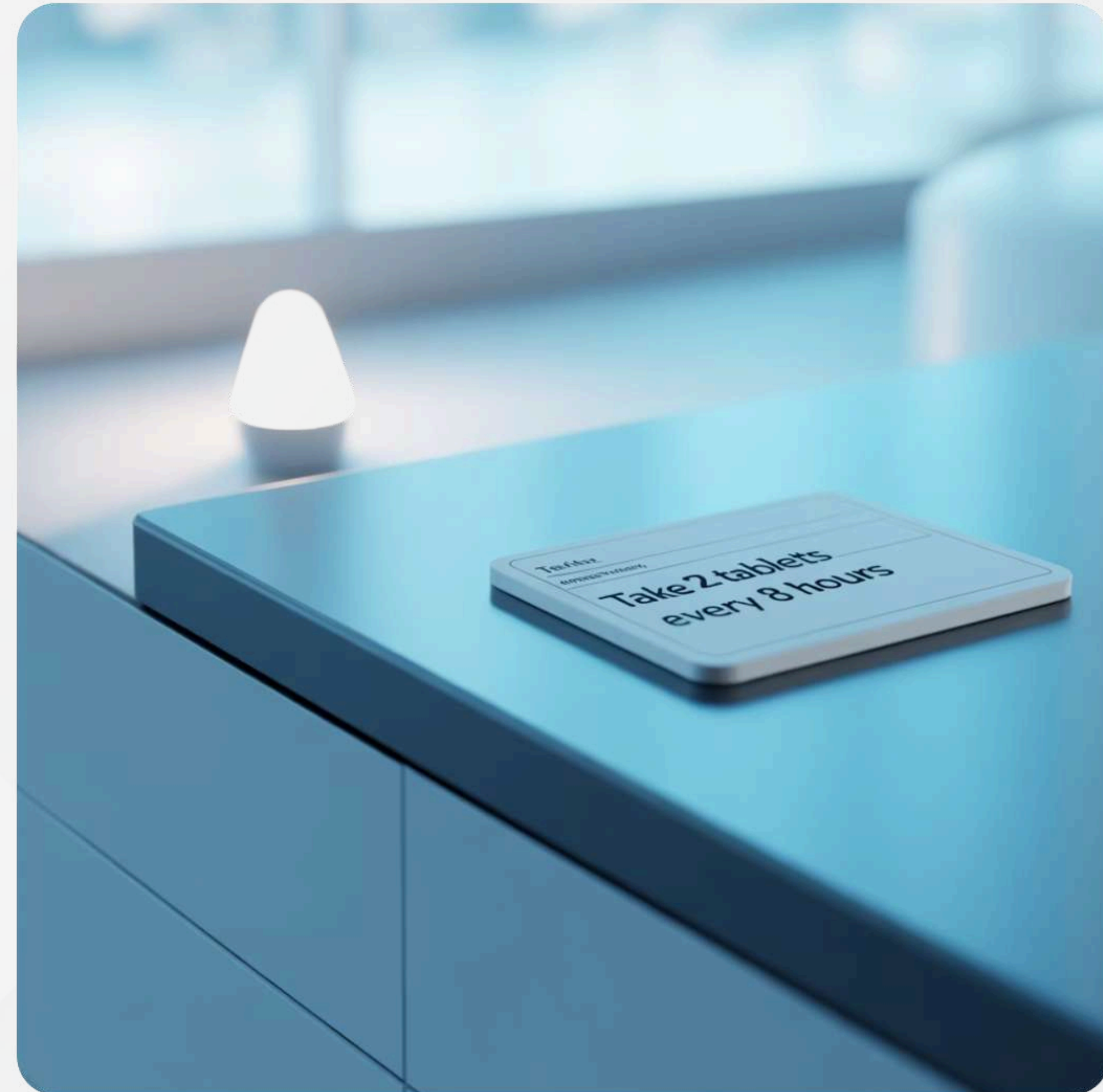

Frequency

Twice daily (every 12 hours) or as directed by physician

⚠ Important Considerations:

- Adjust dose in renal impairment
- Administer after meals to improve absorption and tolerance





Safety & Tolerability

Generally Well-Tolerated

Possible side effects:

- Nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea
- Mild gastric discomfort
- Rare allergic reactions (rash, urticaria)

Contraindications

- Hypersensitivity to penicillins, cephalosporins, or beta-lactams
- Severe hepatic dysfunction
- History of cholestatic jaundice with this drug
